Vinification:

The Pinot Grigio grapes are hand selected from vineyards in Eppan. The vines are approximately 15 to 30 years and and are Southeast and Southwest facing. Limestone gravel soil. Fermentation, malolactic fermentation and development on the lees in barrique-tonneaux. Assemblage after nearly a year, followed by at least eight months of further maturation in concrete barrels
