This shimmering, hand-harvested beauty is produced from 70-year-old vines on the slopes of Les Monts Damnés, where Sancerre's Kimmeridgian limestone is most concentrated. Clean and crisp, with green apple, lime zest, fresh-cut grass, and green tea preceding a brisk finish. Anthony and David are following organic practices, although not certified organic. Drink now to 2026.

Vinification:

Entirely hand-harvest from 70 year old vines grown on Sancerre's great "Les Monts Damnés" which roughly translates to the "damned mountain". Fermented using only indigenous yeasts and no use of oak.
